General Statement of Duties

Under the direction of the Parks and Recreation Director, the Umpire must maintain a recreational perspective when officiating games, detect infractions and penalties according to regulations. The Umpire will enforce rules for adult slow pitch softball and maintain a safe playing environment.

Qualification Requirements

To perform this job successfully, an individual must possess basic knowledge of softball rules and regulations. Individual must be knowledgeable in the area of slow-pitch softball.

Physical Requirements

To successfully function in this position individuals must be able to stand, walk, run (forward and backward), squat, sit, jump, raise and lower arms, shout and blow whistle.

Desirable Education and Experience

Must be at least 18 years of age and some experience with adult slow-pitch softball.
