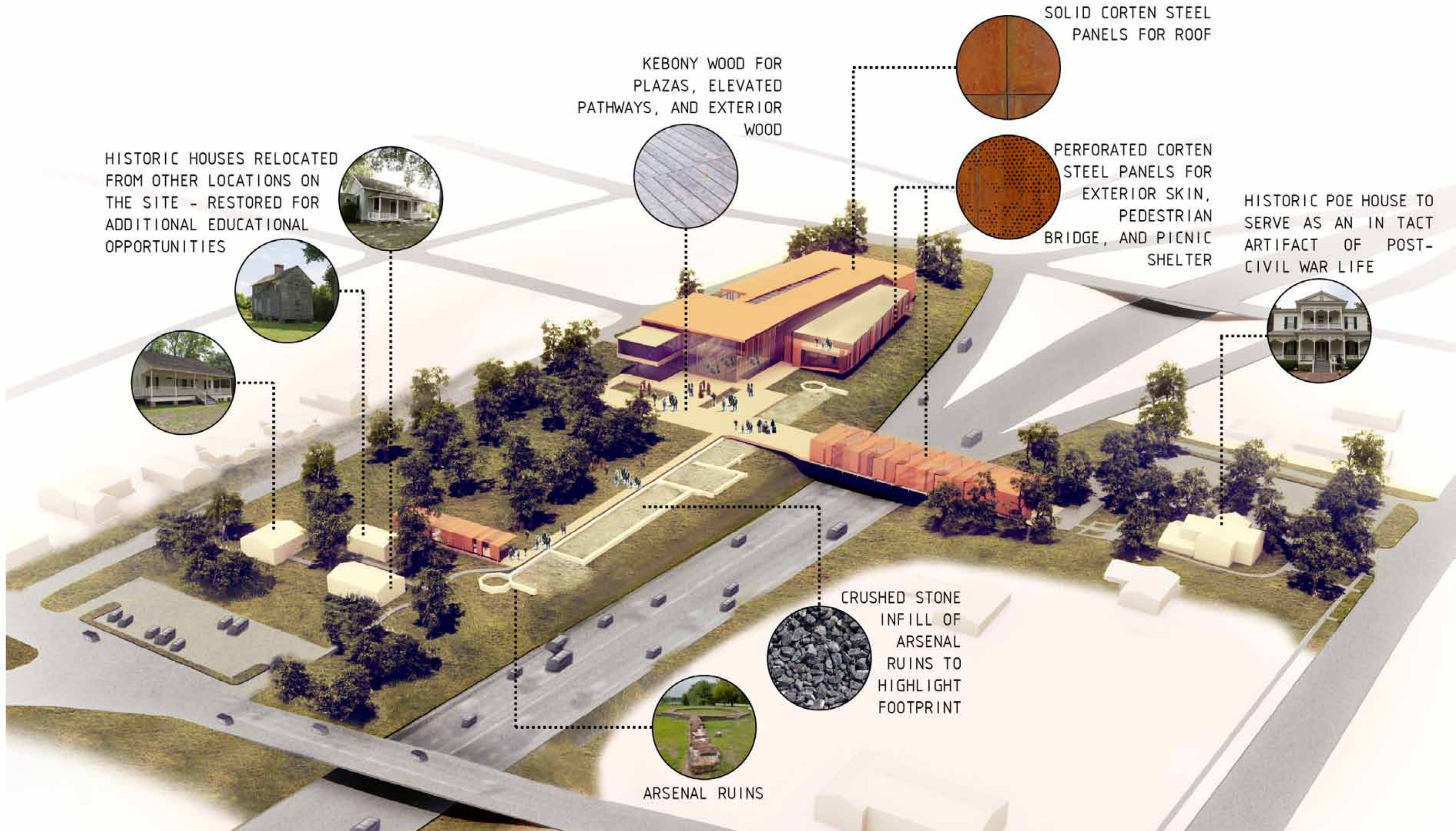
# FAYETTEVILLE ARSENAL

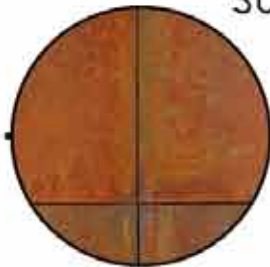

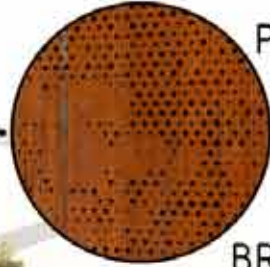
